<p>This program is intended to serve the needs of college and university graduates who wish to add a Bible major to their previous four-year degree and students over the age of 25 with 64 semester credits of transferable general education credits. The large number of elective hours may be used to develop a specific course of study tailored to your needs and arranged around your previous education.
